Diamond Dots Guidelines

Age Groups:

Beginner: Ages 7-11 Junior: Ages 12-15 Senior: 16-19

Notes:

- Only one exhibit allowed per year.
- Purchased kits allowed.
- Skill levels must increase each year exhibited in this category.
- Make sure you properly "finish" your project.
 - When finished, it is advised to put a protective sheet (not waxed paper) over your picture and firmly roll a rolling pin over it to make sure your dots are "set".
 - After rolling the rolling pin over your picture, lay several heavy books on it, completely covering
 it for at least overnight.
- Carefully frame your picture, making sure there is a hanging mechanism on the back to hang the display on the wall.
- Do not use glass. It is recommended by several makers of Diamond Dot type kits that the picture is not put behind glass, plexiglass, etc. of any kind as this may dull the dots.
